Society for Labour and Development is releasing a report on '***Access to Rights and Entitlements for Internal Migrants in India***'. The report explores policy barriers in recognizing and facilitating access to basic needs by migrant workers, gaps in social protection mechanisms as migrants travel through multiple states and administrative and jurisdiction restrictions that are governed by distinct laws, policies, eligibility criteria and social norms exacerbating marginalization of social groups like Dalits, Adivasis, women, religious minorities etc. The release followed by discussion will aim to identify the multiple problems that migrant workers experience in accessing their rights and entitlements in source and destination as a result of their intersecting identities and will call for a collective action to secure the rights of migrant workers.
